It is submitted that the Annual Accounts of the University for the year 2020-21 were prepared as per provisions of Statute 7(7)(c) and were presented before the Finance Committee in terms of Statutes 17(7) in its 31^{st} meeting



held on 27.08.2021 vide item No.31.6. The Finance Committee accorded its approval and recommended the same to the Executive Council for approval. The Executive Council accorded its approval vide item No. 52.20 in its 52nd meeting held on 04.10.2021. The Accounts duly approved by the Executive Council was submitted to the Pr. Director of Audit (Central), Chandigarh to conduct the Audit. The audit was conducted w.e.f. 08.11.2021 to 21.11.2021 at Central University of Himachal Pradesh, Dharamshala (H.P.). The Separate Audit Report (English Version) has been received by the University on 31.03.2022 and is enclosed at Annexure 34.4. The Hindi version of said Accounts have also been prepared. As per Sub-Section (2) of Section 31 of the Act, the approval of the Executive Council is essential before submission of these Accounts for approval of the Court and Visitor of CUHP.
