MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION IN 05 Years Integrated Programme in Hotel Management (Bachelors in Hotel Management-Masters in Hotel Management (BHM-MHM)) PROGRAMME OF STUDY The minimum eligibility requirements and selection criteria for admission are as under:

PROGRAMME OF STUDY	MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT
IN HOTEL MANAGEMENT-MASTERS	A minimum of 50% marks or an equivalent grade in 10+2 examination of a recognized school board or an equivalent examination by authorized board of state/national level.
,	ks: Delayation in minimum qualifying marks up to a maximum of EV shall be made

Relaxation in minimum qualifying marks: Relaxation in minimum qualifying marks up to a maximum of 5% shall be made in case of candidates belonging to the SC, ST, OBC (Non-creamy layer) and persons with disabilities categories.

Procedure of application for admission

- All admissions shall be made through Online Applications received in response to the admission notification.
- Online Application: A candidate can apply online by clicking on the link given on the University website (www.cuhimachal.ac.in). Application fee shall be payable as per the instructions.
- The application fee for admission to Certificate/UG/PG/PG Diploma programmes for different categories of applicants shall be as under:

a) General Category/EWS/OBC (Creamy Layer) : Rs 500/b) OBC Category (Non Creamy Layer) : Rs 400/c) SC/ST/Divyang : Rs 200/-

• Application fee is not refundable in any circumstances.

Selection Criterion

- 1. All applicants seeking admission to 05 Years Integrated Programme in Hotel Management (Bachelors in Hotel Management-Masters in Hotel Management (BHM-MHM)) of study shall be admitted on the basis of merit as per Minimum Eligibility Requirement.
- 2. Selection Criteria for Admission:
 - Admission will be done on the merit basis in the qualifying examination (10+2 or equivalent).
 Note: Candidates who have appeared in the qualifying examinations (10+2 or equivalent) and have been placed in compartment (supplementary) will not be eligible for the admission to 05 Years Integrated Programme in Hotel Management (Bachelors in Hotel Management-Masters in Hotel Management (BHM-MHM)) program of study.
