Academic lectures recorded at Media Lab:

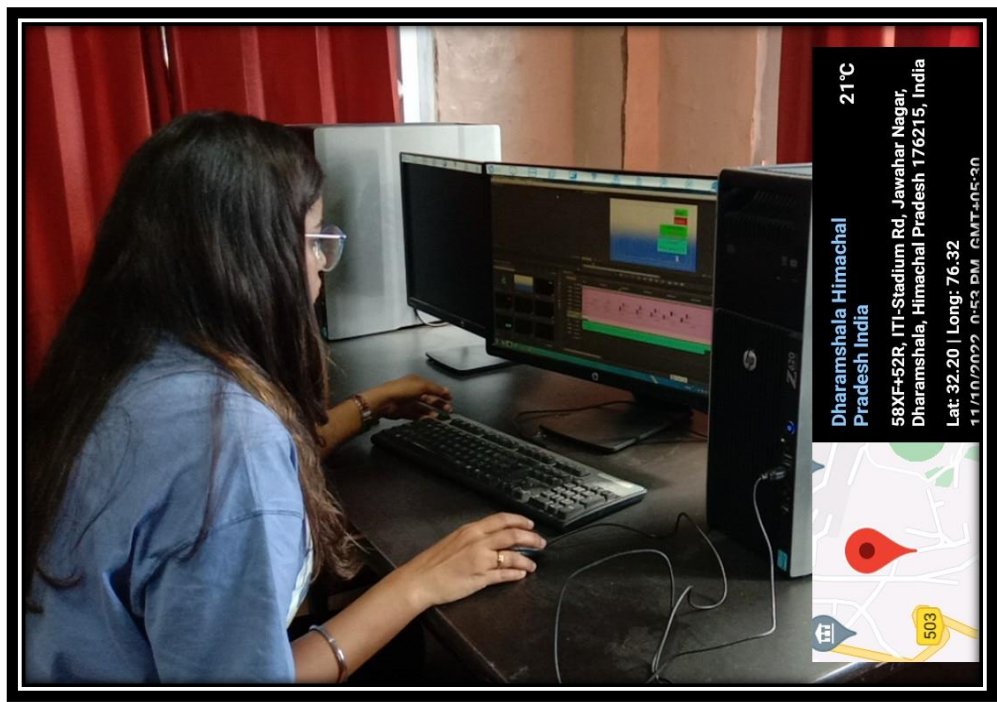
